



Christopher Lopez serves as the Operations Manager of TM2. In this role, he will support TM2 business activities and strategic initiatives related to business development, operations, research and client engagements.

Immediately prior to joining TM2, Christopher served in a project-based role for Fox Entertainment Group's Diversity & Inclusion (D&I) team. In this role, Christopher was charged with developing and managing online presence (overall social media development, web development for D&I hub, live streaming accessibility, etc.), contributing to the foundational build of the company's Employee Resource Groups (ERGs), and creatively enhancing overall workforce experience through organizing studio-wide special events, educational engagements, and programmatic support.
