



Sidney A. Ribeau, Ph.D. is currently Professor of Communications at Howard University. He previously served as Howard's 16th president . At Howard Ribeau funded over \$200 million in capital projects, including two residential halls and a state of the art STEM building. He lead an assessment of all university academic programs, implemented a shared services business model, and initiated the Students First Initiative.

Prior to joining Howard, Ribeau served 13 years as President of Bowling Green State University in Bowling Green, Ohio. Here he completed a \$150 million comprehensive campaign, built a student union, performing arts center, convocation center, and a football training facility. He started and endowed the President's Leadership Academy which has since been named the Ribeau Leadership Academy.

Throughout his career Ribeau has served as provost, dean at two campuses, and tenured professor at five campuses. He has published several scholarly papers, co-authored a book, and written a number editorials and articles for the media. He was selected Educator of the Year by the World Affairs Council, and received the President's Award from The National Association of Student Personnel Administrators.

Ribeau has served on a number of boards and commissions for public and private organizations. He is a Trustee at TIAA-CREF financial services and a Board member, Worthington, Industries, Inc.
